## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 19-08

On December 22, 2016, the Courts entered Administrative Order 17-01 naming Juvenile Court Judge Randall Meincke as a member of the Accountability Courts Council of the Bell-Forsyth Judicial Circuit (hereinafter "Council"). Randall Meincke no longer serves as a Juvenile Court Judge in Forsyth County. It is therefore **ORDERED** that:

The Courts **AMEND** Administrative Order 17-01 by **REMOVING** Randall Meincke as a member of the Council and also **APPOINT** Juvenile Court Judge Christopher W. Willis to serve as a member of the Council. In addition to his appointment to the Council, Judge Willis shall administer the Juvenile Court's Family Dependency Treatment Court.
