IN RE: PRESIDING JUDGE RESPONSIBILITIES

For the efficient and proper administration of justice in the Bell-Forsyth Judicial Circuit, it is necessary to assign a Presiding Judge. Each month, on a rotating basis, one Superior Court judge will be designated to serve as the Presiding Judge for the purposes expressed in this administrative order.


The following shall be presented to the Presiding Judge for review and or signature:

1. Applications for Search Warrants
2. Common Market Applications
3. Emergency matters where the Assigned Judge is unavailable
4. Upon specific request, matters for the Assigned Judge

All other matters are to be handled by the Assigned Judge. Motions and proposed orders should be routed accordingly.

Unless otherwise agreed by the Superior Court Judges, the Presiding Judge will be on call from 8:30 a.m. on the first day of the month until 5:00 p.m. on the last day of the month. It will be the responsibility of the Presiding Judge to provide for a replacement during periods of his unavailability.
