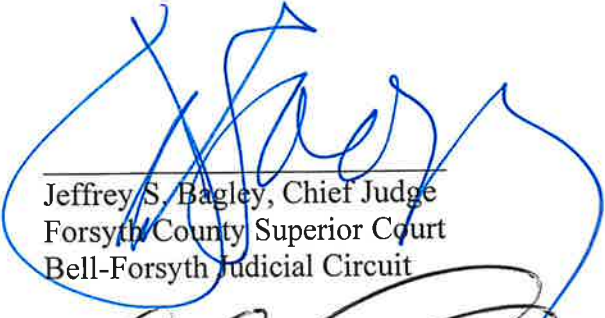
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 25-09 CLERK SUPERIOR COURT

Pursuant to OCGA § 15-1-16(b)(8), the Honorable Christopher Willis, who is the presiding judge in the Juvenile Court of Forsyth County, has agreed to assist the Chief Superior Court Judge by presiding as Judge of the felony Mental Health Court (Changing, Assisting, Restoring, and Enlightening for Mental Health Offenders ("C.A.R.E. Program")) Division of Division 1 of the Forsyth County Superior Court until further Court order.

In this capacity, Judge Willis is fully clothed with the powers of a Superior Court judge within the felony Mental Health Court (C.A.R.E. Program) and is authorized to preside over all matters coming before the Superior Court in the Mental Health Court Division of Division I.

During periods of Judge Willis's absence or unavailability, the Honorable Heather N. Dunn is authorized to assist and is fully clothed with the power of a Superior Court judge within the felony Mental Health Court (C.A.R.E. Program). Judge Willis shall complete the attached *Order for Judicial Assistance* in order for Judge Dunn to preside in his place. See Exhibit "A". The *Order for Judicial Assistance* shall be filed with the Clerk of Superior Court and a stamp-filed copy forwarded to the Director of Forsyth County Accountability Courts. 1st

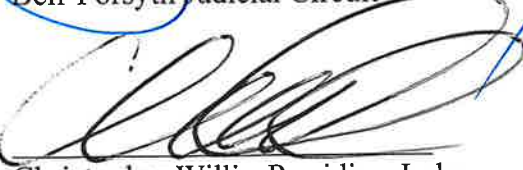
